The committee agrees in the criteria for evaluation in the first and second phase, which is detailed below:

CRITERIA FOR SCORING THE MERITS OF CANDIDATES (“Neuroscience and Neurophysiology”)

*The following scoring for merits will be assigned taking into account their adequacy to the position topic “Neuroscience and Neurophysiology”. These criteria will be applied both to the **first** and **second** evaluation stages in the selection process.*

1. **Research merits (60 points):**
 - Number and quality of Publications (relevant authorship). 0-15 points
 - Number and quality of Publications (other co-authorship). 0-10 points
 - Number of european/international or national funded projects as PI or as consortium group leader. 0-12 points
 - Number of funded projects as co-applicant or member of the research team. 0-10 points
 - Contracts with industry. 0-2 points
 - Invited lectures (congresses and other universities/institutions). 0-6 points
 - Prizes/Awards. 0-2 points
 - Patents. 0-2 points
 - Other research merits. 0-1 points
2. **Teaching merits (25 points):**
 - Teaching experience at university level. 0-6 points
 - Managing/organization of university teaching. 0-4 points
 - Supervision of PhD theses. 0-7 points
 - Supervision of Undergraduate or Master theses. 0-3 points
 - Certifications/Accreditations on teaching. 0-2 points
 - Evaluation of teaching quality. 0-2 points
 - Other teaching merits. 0-1 point
3. **Other professional merits (15 points):**
 - Work experience in laboratories and universities outside the home institution. 0-10 points
 - Service to the profession (e.g. editorial boards, project/paper reviewer). 0-3 points
 - Service to institutions (e.g university committees, scientific society committees, managing activities). 0-2 points

A candidate will pass to the second stage if he/she gets more than 70 (of a total of 100 points). From candidates passing to the second stage, the committee will select top 2-3 candidates for oral defence. If there are no candidates that fulfil this condition, the committee will consider the cases of the top candidates in order to select up to two of them for passing to the second stage.

During the **second phase**, the assessment of merits described above will be based on public oral defence in ENGLISH. The oral defence will last about 1.5h per candidate. Each selected candidate will have the opportunity



to present orally his/her CV, academic teaching expertise and current/future research projects for a maximum of 60 minutes, followed by a question period with the evaluation Committee (up to 30 minutes). The candidates should explain his/her CV including particular strengths (high quality papers, funded fellowships/grants, mentoring PhD/master students...) as well as his/her participation in teaching activities related to neurophysiology or neuroscience. Also, the candidates should explain his current research project/activities, results and future perspectives in the area of research. Evaluation will be based on the same criteria as the first phase and a minimum of 70 points will be necessary to obtain a positive evaluation.

Contra aquest acord de la comissió, que no esgota la via administrativa i és un acte de tràmit, és aplicable l'establert per l'article 112 de la Llei 39/2015, d'1 d'octubre, de procediment administratiu comú de les Administracions Públiques, segons el qual contra les resolucions i els actes de tràmit, si aquests últims decideixen directament o indirectament el fons de l'afer, determinen la impossibilitat de continuar el procediment, produeixen indefensió o perjudici irreparable a drets i interessos legítims, els interessats poden interposar recurs d'alçada, en aquest cas davant el rector, en el termini d'un mes, a comptar de l'endemà de la seva publicació, d'acord amb el que estableixen els articles 121 i 122 de la Llei 39/2015, d'1 d'octubre, del procediment administratiu comú de les administracions públiques.

Contra este acuerdo de la comisión, que no agota la vía administrativa y es un acto de trámite, es aplicable lo establecido por el artículo 112 de la Ley 39/2015, de 1 de octubre, de procedimiento administrativo común de las Administraciones Públicas, según el cual contra las resoluciones y los actos de trámite, si estos últimos deciden directamente o indirectamente el fondo del asunto, determinan la imposibilidad de continuar el procedimiento, producen indefensión o perjuicio irreparable a derechos e intereses legítimos, los interesados pueden interponer recurso de alzada, en este caso ante el rector, en el plazo de un mes, a contar a partir del día siguiente de su publicación, de acuerdo lo que establecen los artículos 121 y 122 de la Ley 39/2015, de 1 de octubre, del procedimiento administrativo común de las administraciones públicas.

This decision of the Committee is an act of procedural law and does not exhaust your right of appeal through administrative channels. Article 112 of Law 39 of 1 October 2015 on the legal framework governing public administrations and common administrative procedures allows you to appeal when resolutions and acts of procedural law directly or indirectly affect the basis of the legal process underway, obstruct that process, or undermine or cause irreparable harm to legitimate rights and interests. Under such circumstances, you may present a request for further review, in this case by the Rector, within one month from the day after the publication of the Committee's decision, pursuant to articles 121 and 122 of Law 39 of 1 October 2015 on the legal framework governing public administrations and common administrative procedures.
