



## **APPENDIX 3. DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED**

Grant recipients must submit the following documentation within **20 working days** of the date of publication of this resolution in the UB electronic office. Documents should be sent by email to requalificacio.su@ub.edu

- Confirmation of acceptance of the grant (Appendix 4).
- Certified copy or valid equivalent of DNI/NIE/passport (valid ID)
- Certified copy or valid equivalent of the doctoral degree certificate.
- If applicable, certified copy or valid equivalent of official certification of a degree of disability equal to or greater than 33% and of the ruling issued by the assessment and guidance committee of the Catalan Department of Social Rights confirming that the recipient is able to carry out the functions corresponding to the position the recipient will occupy during the grant period.
- Sworn statements declaring compliance with the requirements established in the grant call as shown below:
  - Requirements established in paragraphs *a*, *c* and *e* of Article 5.1 of the general terms and conditions.
  - Requirements established in the specific terms and conditions:
    - 4.6 specific terms and conditions Margarita Salas
    - 4.4 specific terms and conditions Requalification
    - 4.5 specific terms and conditions María Zambrano
- In the case of non-EU foreign citizens and individuals who do not fall within the scope of application of international treaties signed by the European Union and ratified by Spain, a work and residence permit. Submission of this document may be deferred until the date on which the contract is signed.

## Documents that have already been submitted to the University of Barcelona do not need to be re-submitted.

Candidates who are unable to submit the required documentation in the stipulated period notwithstanding duly justified instances of force majeure, at the discretion of the awarding body - and those who do not meet the stated requirements are not eligible to receive the grant and may not enter into a contractual relationship with the University. In such cases, the grant award will be annulled, without prejudice to any responsibility candidates may have incurred through the provision of false information.

If the confirmation of acceptance of the grant and, where applicable, the contract are not signed in the terms and within the period established in the regulations - notwithstanding duly justified and verified instances of force majeure - candidates will lose all entitlement to the grant and to the conditions offered in the grant call.
