Assessment Criteria (UB-LE-212-022)

FIRST FASE

The first phase consists of an assessment of the merits provided by each candidate taking in account the following criteria:

1. Research Merits: 70 points

Credit should be given to research achievements that are framed within the research knowledge area of Immunology.

1.1. Publications in indexed journals: *40 points*

Significance and impact of scientific publications; specific contribution to papers. The highest qualification should be given to publications, preferentially in the field of immunology, in which the candidate plays a relevant role (first, last, or corresponding author) and indexed by ISI Web of Science within the Q1.

1.2. Research funding: *10 points*

Participation in competitive research projects. The highest qualification should be given to the leadership capacity of the candidate.

1.3. Research stays/networking: *10 points*

Mobility, international visibility and collaborations.

The highest qualification should be given to stays in prestigious International Universities or Research Centers over two years.

1.4. Other research merits: *10 points*

Including knowledge-transfer activities, intellectual property rights, and registered patents.

2. Teaching Merits: 25 points

The highest qualification should be given to the teaching experience in BSc or MSc courses in the subject of Immunology.

2.1. Teaching activities: *15 points*

Given in official degrees, diversity and dedication

2.2. Direction of Msc and PhD thesis: *10 points*

3. Other merits: 5 points



Professional achievements that could be relevant for the profile of the post, including awards, committee experiences, and assessment panels.

The 3 candidates with the highest score (and always greater than *50 points*) will pass to a second phase.

SECOND PHASE

The second phase consists of a candidate interview.

Candidates should present themselves reporting the most relevant aspects of their CV (maximum of 15 min) and give a seminar explaining their research within the Immunology area planned for the following years (maximum of 45 min). After the presentation, the committee will ask questions regarding the candidate's CV, the seminar or any other aspects related to the post offered (maximum 60 min). This exercise will be in English.

In addition to the assessment criteria of the first phase, which may be re-evaluated after committee questions regarding the candidate CV (*60 points*), evaluation of the second phase will consider the suitability of the candidate for the contract offered (tenure-eligible lecturer), the ability to develop new lines of research complementary to the ones existing in the Department, and the capacity to establish collaborations and innovate, based on the CV, the seminar given and further committee questions related to the post offered and the activity to be developed (*40 points*).

To pass to the list of candidates eligible for the post at least *70 points* in the second phase will be required. The committee will nominate the candidate with the highest score.
