Teaching merits (45 %)

- A. Teaching dedication and experience
 - University teaching taught (first and second cycle, degree, postgraduate)
 - Supervised tutorial work
- B. Quality of teaching activity
 - Positive official assessments of the activity
 - Original teaching material and teaching publications
 - Teaching innovation projects

Research merits (45 %):

- C. Quality of the results of the research activity
 - Scientific indexed publications
 - Other scientific publications
 - Books and book chapters
- D. Visiting scholarships in research and academic centers
- E. Participation in projects or in research contracts, especially those with international projection
- F. Outstanding participation in national and international congresses
- G. Conferences and seminars taught at research centers

Other aspects (10 %):

- H. Prizes and awards
- I. Institutional responsibilities in university or faculty management
- J. Knowledge transfer to from Academy to Society
- K. Other merits

SECOND Phase:

In the second exercise, in addition to the specific criteria already mentioned in the curriculum vitae, the quality of the presentation of the seminar and the activity planned to be developed will be at the core of the evaluation, including the candidate's answers to the questions raised by the members of the Commission.
